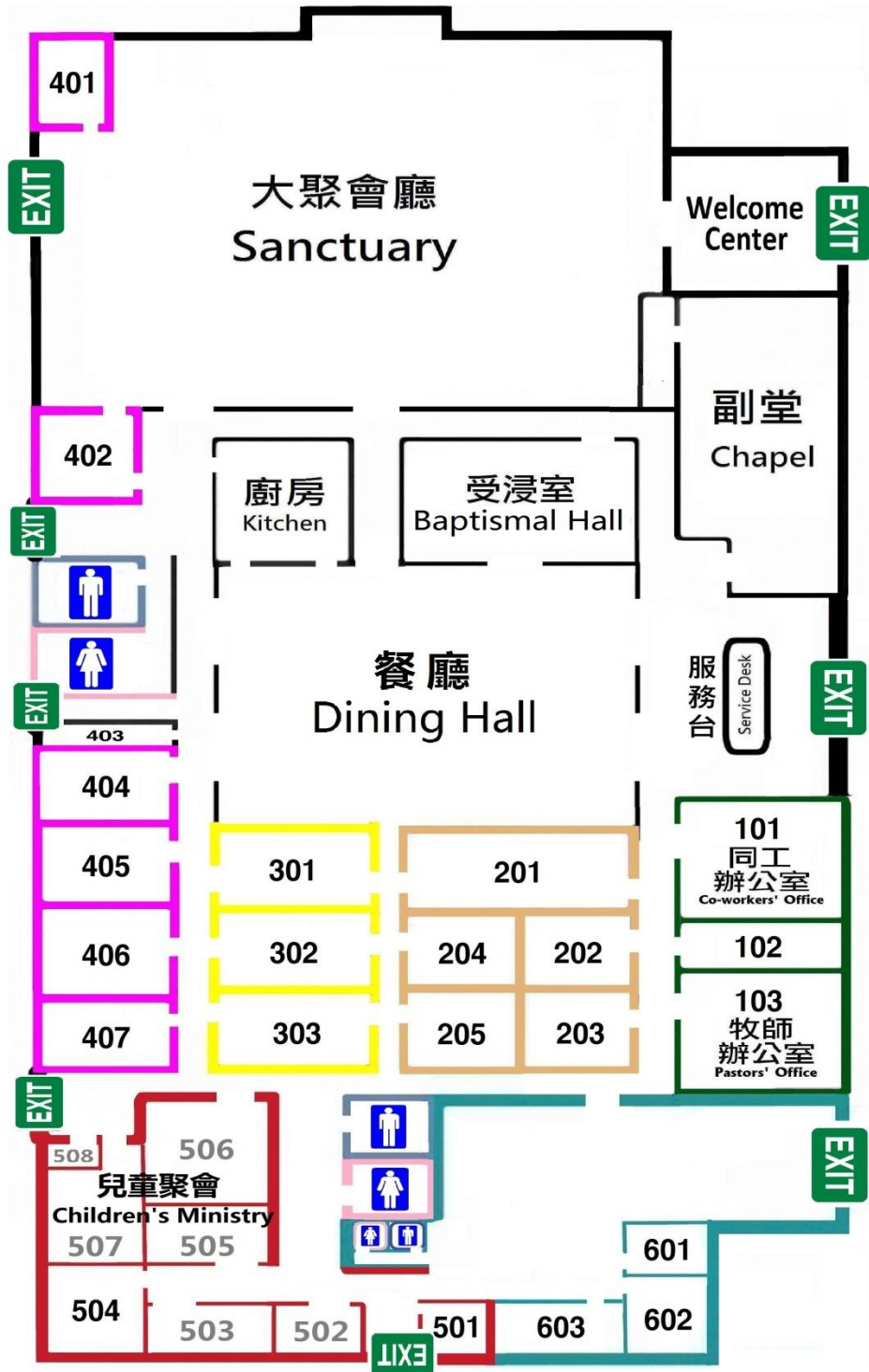

Theme: THE HOLY REVELATION OF JESUS CHRIST
Speaker: Brother Newman Sze

Message I: The Source of the Life of Christ and the Revelation of His Holy Being – Who Christ Really Is?

Bible Verses : Proverbs 8:22-31 ; Matthew 1:1 ; 16:13-20 ; John 12:34-36 ; 17:3 ; Romans 1:1-4 ; 14:9; Hebrews 5:5 ; 13:8 ; Revelation 1:4-6

1. The holy and eternal source of Jesus Christ, the Word that became flesh
2. Jesus is the everlasting light by which we should walk and become the children of light
3. Jesus Christ came in through two ways: faith and the cross
4. The Holy Spirit reveals the great authority brought by Christ
5. The indwelling Christ is our eternal life
6. Two realms of the Son of God: in flesh and in spirit
7. The death and resurrection of Christ have enabled him to become the Lord of the living and the dead
8. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever
9. Jesus Christ rose from the dead to be the King and Ruler of this world

Message II: Fleshly Christ and Mysterious Christ

Bible Verses: *Matthew 16:13-20; John 15:1-8 ; Acts 11:25-26 ; Romans 12:1-5 ;
I Corinthians 12:12-14 ; 15:45-49 ; Galatians 3:27-29 ; Revelation 21:9-11*

1. The Holy Meaning of “The Son of Man”

- (一) “The Son of Man” is a corporate person, that is, the church
- (二) The power of hell cannot overcome the church
- (三) I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven
- (四) Whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven

2. I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me, you will bear much fruit

3. The great meaning of “Christian”

4. The diminishing of individuals and the appearing of the body of Christ

5. We are the great revelation of the body of Christ

- (i) All saints are members of body of Christ
- (ii) Every member lives out his or her functions to show forth the body of Christ.

6. Two great men

- (i) As was the earthly man, so are those who are of the earth
- (ii) As is the man from heaven, so also are those who are of heaven
- (iii) His life has swallowed death, so we can triumph through Jesus Christ

7. The truth regarding baptizing into Christ – put on Christ and become one body in Christ

8. The New Bride and the City of the New Jerusalem

Message III: The Glorification of Christ and the Glorification of Church

Bible Verses : Colossians 1:13-20 ; 2:9-12 ; I Corinthians 15:20-28 , 49-57 ; Ephesians 1:13-14 ; 3:6 ; Philippians 3:20-21 ; Revelation 11:15-18 ; 19:1-7

1. God's beloved son is the image of God and has supremacy over all things
2. All the fullness is in Christ, and through him the church acquires the same fullness
3. God has performed spiritual circumcision on us through the resurrection of Christ, with whom we died, were buried, and rose from the dead
4. Resurrection according to one's own turn versus striving to gain the better resurrection
5. Death has been swallowed by the Lord's victory so church can now boast over sin and death
6. Holy Spirit is the seal and the deposit
7. We are co-offspring in the same body of Christ with the same promise
8. Heavenly citizenship and redemption of the body
9. The kingdom of this world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ
10. The great multitude of Hallelujah

Message IV: Our Experiences regarding the Risen Christ and the Descending of the Kingdom of Christ

Bible Verses : I Corinthians 15:17-20 ; II Corinthians 1:19-20 ; 2:12-15 ; 5:17-18 ; 10:5 ; 12:3 ; 6:16; Ephesians 4:13 ; I Peter 2:5-9 ; Revelation 11:15 ; 12:10 ; 20:6

1. Christ becomes the firstfruits of those who fell asleep and will later be made alive in their own turn
2. Church has overcome and spreaded His aroma
3. If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, and the new has come.
4. The blood of Christ cleanses our consciences from acts that lead to death so that we can serve the living God.
5. Church is the spiritual house built by God, the royal priesthood, and a holy nation that declares the praises of him who called her out of darkness into his wonderful light.
6. The rapture of overcomers and the church
7. The first resurrection and the second death
8. The church will reign with Christ.

Morning Message Outline
Speaker: Brother Ernest Waldvogel

MESSAGE I:

As we recognize who Jesus Christ is, the only proper response is worship. Who Jesus is not something we can just understand with our minds but it is the revelation of who Jesus is in our hearts, by illumination, that brings about the response of worship. We will read parts of Acts 17 and also John 4. (This will be quite different from the two workshop sessions). We are all very good worshippers. It is the activity of the human soul. Everybody worships. The object of our worship is based on what we place value on. We worship well but sometimes we are worshipping little gods. That is not so much defined by what we say. It is defined by how we live. It is more with our lives than with our mouths. Our worship is how we live and what we say. May the Lord reveal Himself to us in order that we may see who He is and respond to Him in a way that He is worthy of. That we would "present our bodies to Him as living sacrifices, which is our spiritual act of worship."
Romans 12:1

MESSAGE II:

Jesus is revealed as the divine Son of God that takes away the sin of the world. In Him all our wounds were healed. As we see Him we can by faith be free from any hurts that life has thrown at us. We find our wounds healed in Jesus. Every wrong that we have done and every wrong that has been done to us has been swallowed up in every right that Jesus has done and in every wrong done to Him. May we find in Him the freedom that He has died to bring to us. We will focus in Isaiah 53.
